

Selectmen Meeting Minutes
April 20, 2022

Meeting called to order by Selectmen Norman Beckwith at 6:00pm.

Calling of the Roll

Norman made a motion to accept the minutes as written. David seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

The Treasure's warrant was handed out.

Norman asked Kirk how Linda was doing with the ARPA Covid Funding paperwork. Kirk said he will ask Linda and will get back to him.

Marion discussed this year's school budget. They have 1 student going out and 3 students coming in.

Norman said Linda would be at the Budget Meeting Thursday April 21st at 6:00pm in the Shirley Library and Carolyn had already posted it in the Post Office and Website.

Derek gave to the selectmen a couple of articles about Accessory Dwelling Unit and Acreage that he wanted to put in the town warrant to be voted on at the Town Meeting. Both were referring to changing the Shirley Land Use Ordinance. Norman explained to them you can go to the Planning Board and submit it to them and if they can't help then you can go to the Appeals Board and ask for a variance.

Crystal was inquiring about someone's property and if they were paying a property tax on it. Norman said that properties as of April 1st will be assessed and taxed after the assessor goes around and takes care of those properties.

Norman will ask Mark Freeman about sweeping the roads.

Norman spoke with Joe Guyotte about the residents who haven't come in to register their dogs. Joe told Norman that it will cost the town more money to chase these people around for not registering their dogs so he will have them sign a piece of paper stating that if the owners dog bites someone the owner will be held responsible.

Norman adjourned the meeting at 7:56pm.
