Meeting called to order by Selectmen Norman Beckwith at 5:58pm.

Calling of the Roll

David made a motion to accept the minutes as amended. Kirk seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

Treasurer's Report was handed out.

The Planning Board will be holding a public hearing on September 6, 2022, at the Town Hall at 6pm for requested 3 lot subdivision on Ames Family Land Company LLC holdings at West Bog.

The taxes that were done a couple of years ago that are input into Trio need to be cleaned up to get the accounts back to a zero balance. Trio will charge \$1,000.00 to clean up the accounts. Geneva is willing to clean up the accounts for \$200.00.

David made a motion to allow Geneva to clean up all accounts in Trio from 2 years ago to a zero balance for \$200.00. Kirk seconded. Motion carried 2-0.

Norman measured Gene Turners fence. It's 100 feet from the tar back to his house. Norman feels Gene needs to remove that 100 feet of fence every fall so the snowplow will have room to push back the snow and turnaround.

Norman is looking into buying a sign for upcoming events in Shirley to post outside for the town residents.

A resident on the Blanchard Road approached Norman wanting the road to be plowed. Norman will explain to the resident for someone who lives on the Blanchard Road to plow the road they will be required to have a contract with liability insurance okayed by the Town of Shirley.

Norman spoke with Vance Lambert, and Vance said he agreed to cut the bushes on the Blanchard Road and around the Town of Shirley after the leaves have fallen off.

Norman asked Carolyn to contact Kelly MacFadyen to find out when the next School Board meeting will be held.

David would like to know who the oldest resident in town is so they can be presented with the Boston Post Cane.
