Bill Beaker who takes care of the ATV and Snowmobile Trails called Norman about insurance. If a snowmobiler goes across your property, the liability insurance is the same for towns and individuals as if you allow someone to cross your property as a verbal agreement it works the same.

Norman brought to the selectmen's attention hearing if he or David were to step on a resident's property that resident would shoot them. Norman felt this needed to be brought to the Sheriff's attention. After a discussion, David made a motion to have Norman call the sheriff's office to keep a dialogue with any type of threat incidents with any Municipal Officer or Municipal Official in town.

Marc of the ATV club spoke with Norman and said they agree with cleaning up the picnic area.

Floyd would like to see the porta potty that is across from the picnic area be moved to a safer spot. Floyd was also concerned that the Monson Fire Department does not have a ladder truck.

Derke is concerned with individuals who don't have leashes on their dogs. Norman recommended that Derek contact the Dog Officer Joe Guyotte.

Crystal would like to see the ATV stop sign moved closer to the road. Norman will ask Marc to move them.
