Selectmen Meeting Minutes March 6, 2024

Selectman Norman Beckwith called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

David made a motion to amend the selectmen meeting minutes from February 21, 2024, as amended. Norman asked that the words south side of R.R. tracks be added to the mowing contract line.

Norman will be speaking to someone at Ware Butler about looking at putting plates on the bottom of the doors at the Town Hall.

Norman asked Carolyn to call the Town Lawyer so the selectmen can discuss what to do with the money from the sale of the tax acquired property at 35 North Rd.

David said the Lower Shirley Corner Road will need to have 6 to 8 culverts. He feels Jordan needs to go around with a bucket full to fill the culverts. Norman will call Jordan.

David spoke with Vera, and she told him there is enough money to install the cameras in the Town Office.

David made a motion to call Seacoast Security to have the cameras installed in the Town Office. Norman seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

David asked Carolyn to call Foss Portable Toilets to get on the list to have it delivered to the Town of Shirley sometime in May.

Norman adjourned the meeting at 7:12pm.
