Select Board Meeting Minutes April 30, 2025

Selectman Bill Nye called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

Calling of the roll

Selectmen: Bill Nye, Barry Bateman, Nick Hanson

Secretary: Carolyn Nye

The selectmen signed the town warrant.

Barry made a motion to accept the meeting minutes from April 2, 2025, as written. Bill seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

Norman asked to put in an article in the town warrant asking if the town would allow the cemetery committee to repair the honor/memorial roll.

Peggy thanked the select board members for allowing her to purchase a laptop for the historical society. Peggy was asking if either the cemetery committee or a committee could be formed to investigate the replacing of the honor/memorial roll because the wood is rotten.

Norman said he spoke to the legion in Greenville, and they are replacing all the name plates with steel. Norman and Peggy would like to investigate how much it will cost to replace the name plates and the entire structure. Norman suggests we replace it with slate, granite or brick, something other than wood.

The select board agreed to allow the cemetery committee to investigate what it will cost to replace the honor /memorial wall and to bring it back to the select board so they can work on this together as a group.

David Thorp feels like some of the names on the honor/memorial wall should be removed because they weren't born here. David's name is on the honor roll in the town he was from in Massachusetts. Nick said this discussion will be tabled.

Roger Labonte asked Nick if he was still interested in being a member of the cemetery committee and Nick responded that he was still on the cemetery committee as far as he knew and he was never informed as to when the committee had meetings.

Carolyn responded that any boards or committees that the Maine state law says that any board or committees who get together to have meetings must inform the public of the meetings and must have meeting minutes.

Tori Arey thanked the select board members for filling in the holes in the roads.

Bill is hoping in the next few weeks to put out some bids to replace some culverts in town.

Jeremy was asking if the town could investigate expanding the liquor license for the sale of liquor on Sunday on premises and off premises.

The select board members said they will investigate to see what needs to be done.

Bill made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:44 pm. Nick seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.
